A medieval bible page that may date back to the thirteenth century has been discovered in Worcestershire County Council's Record Office. It was being used as a wrapper for a sixteenth century Tudor bishop's records. The re-use of bible fragments as protective wrappers for documents was common practice in the Tudor era after the dissolution of the monasteries.
